New Neonatal Resuscitation Guidelines Released. The neonatal resuscitation guidelines and algorithm have been printed in Circulation and reprinted in Pediatrics. The NRP has produced a document summarizing the changes in the guidelines. NRP 7th edition materials will be released in Spring 2016 and must be in use by January 1, 2017.
