

Trusting God Object Lessons

Trusting God Object Lessons - Object Lesson: Add a few drops of food coloring to the water depending on the amount of water used and stir until evenly mixed. “This water represents trusting God.” Write the word trust on a piece of tape as a label for the container. Stick the tape to the container, so the children can see it. Topic: Trusting God. Object Lesson Title: In God We Trust. Object: a penny. Bible Verses: Mark 12:17. Key Takeaway: Whether things are going good or bad, we should always turn our thoughts back to God and trust Him. This object lesson is a fun visual that reminds kids to trust God even when circumstances are looking bad. Use it as an icebreaker for a larger lesson. There is a little bit of “magic” and a little bit of science in this lesson that gives it some “Wow!” factor. Materials: · Canning jar (“Mason jar”) with a screw-top lid and a removable insert. The next time you talk about trusting in God in class, please don’t just repeat the word “trust” a lot like many teachers do. Instead, find a relevant example that the kids would understand (like the one in the script above) and start your explanation with that.
